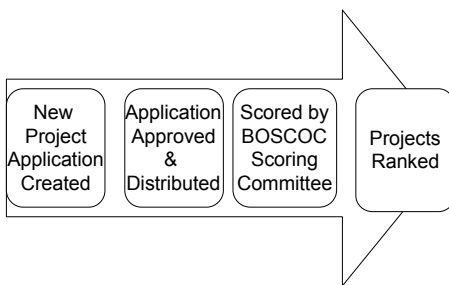

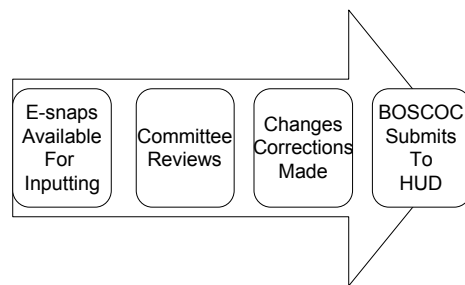


- Meet threshold

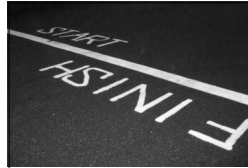

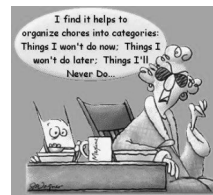
- No applications will be accepted late.

New Projects - March 12

- Use 2010 BOSCO process plan application
- Modeled after Ex. 2 - E-SNAPS
- This is a full application
- **Scored *once*** - based on this application

Logic Model

- Utilizing the 2009 Logic Model, new projects will need to complete a Logic Model to submit with the 2010 New Project Application

Exhibit 1 Submission Tool

- Tool will be released at CoC Training
- Info to be collected:
 - CoC membership list
 - CoC outreach plan
 - CoC participation in linkages to mainstream programs and resources
 - CoC approval of projects
- Score decreased for late submission

HMIS - Exhibit 1

- Requires HMIS Data for one day of the last 5 days in January
 - All client information must be entered by:
February 5, 2010

HMIS - Exhibit 2

- May require Missing/Null data reports
 - Agencies up for their first renewal, should contact Paula to verify complete and accurate data
